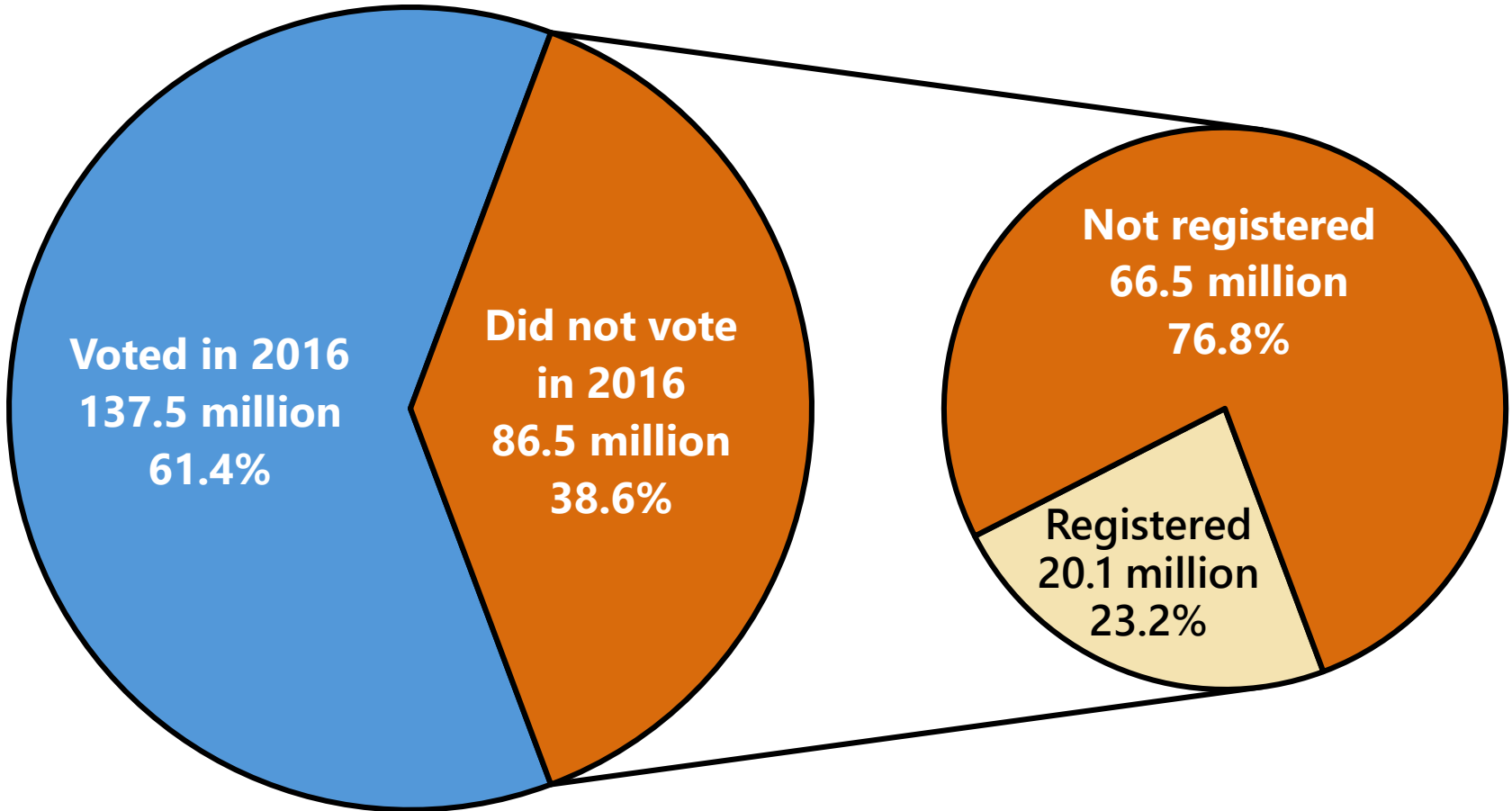

Citizens 18+ years old in 2016

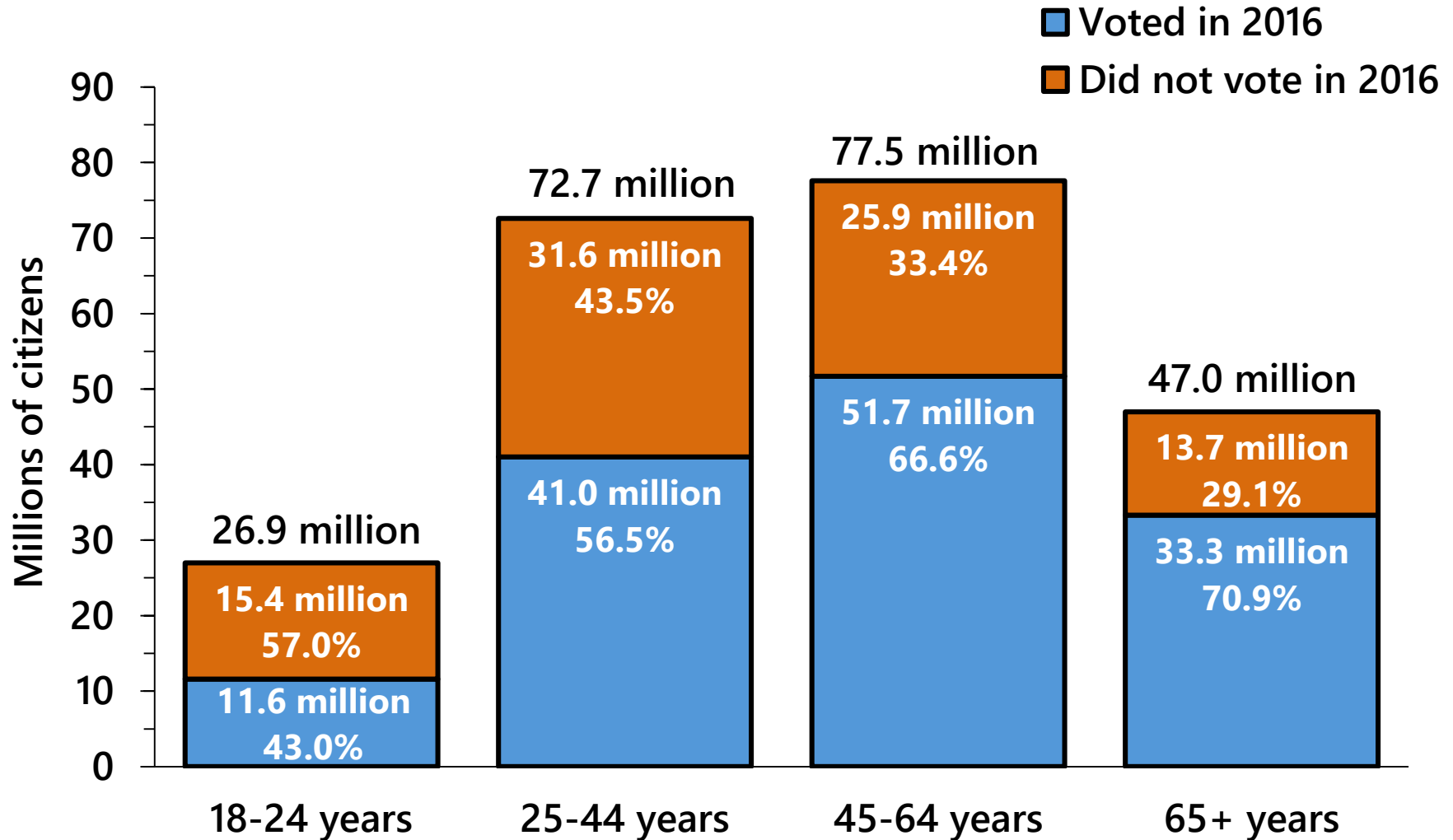

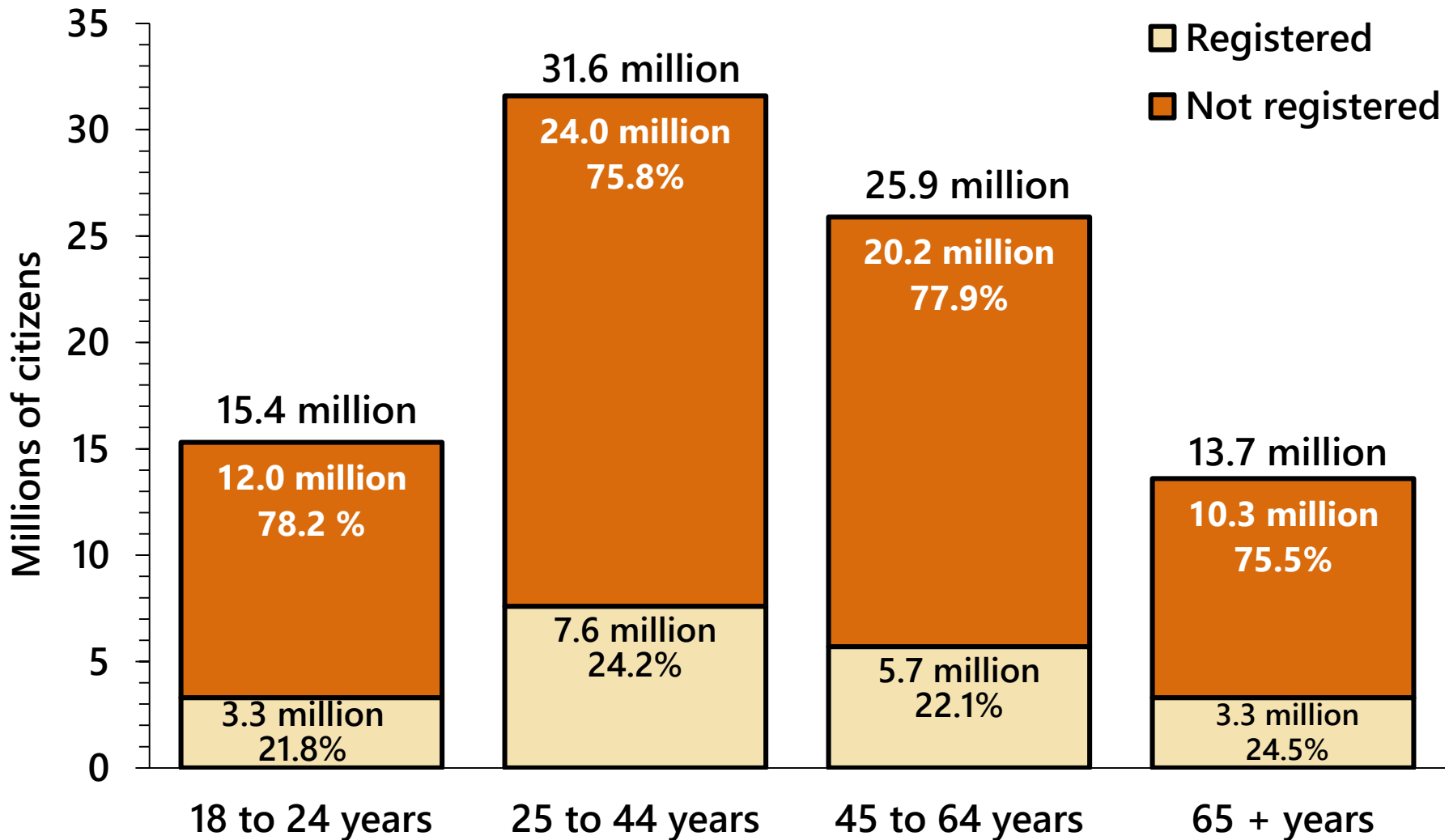

Citizens 18+ years old who did not vote in 2016

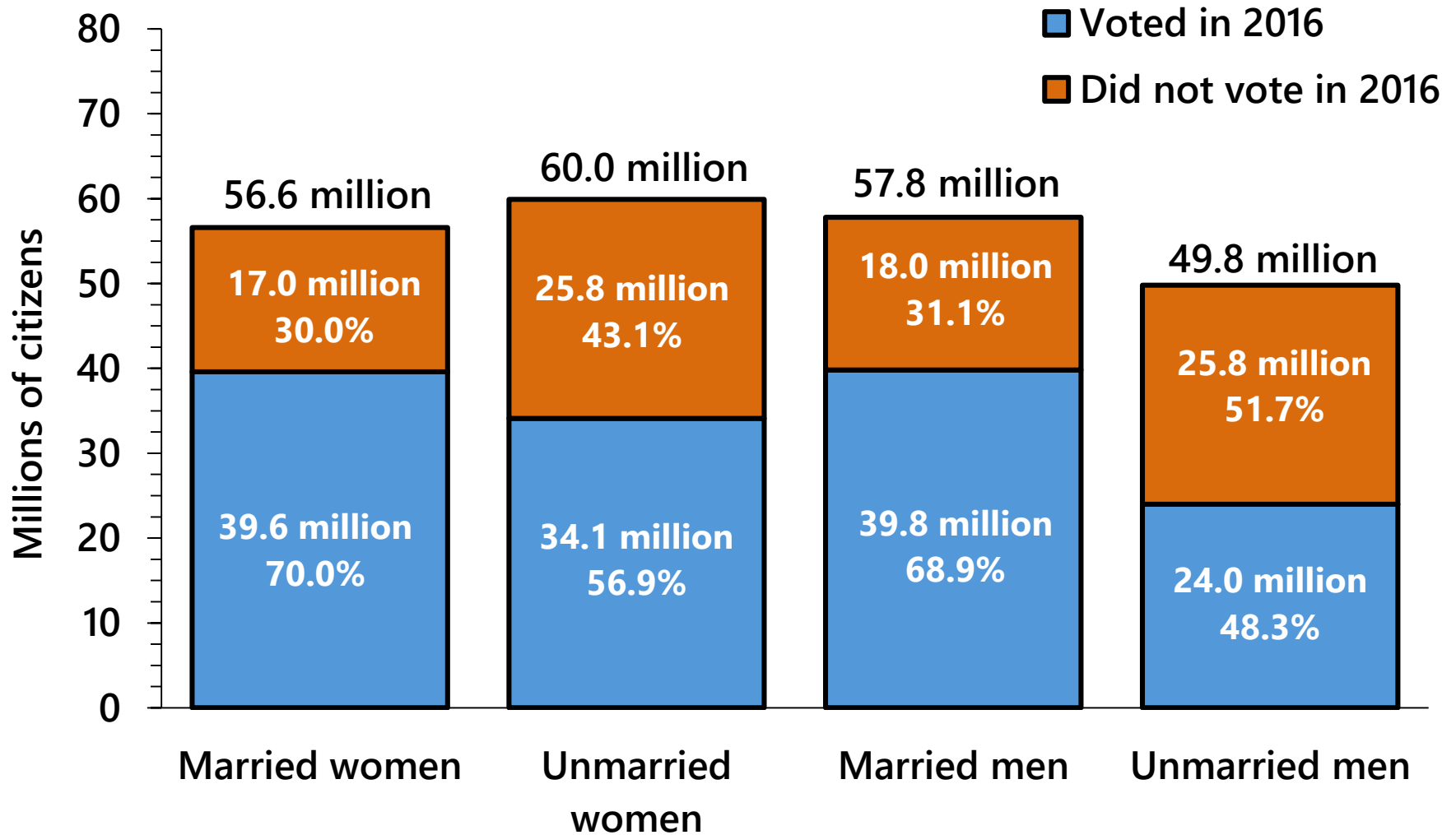

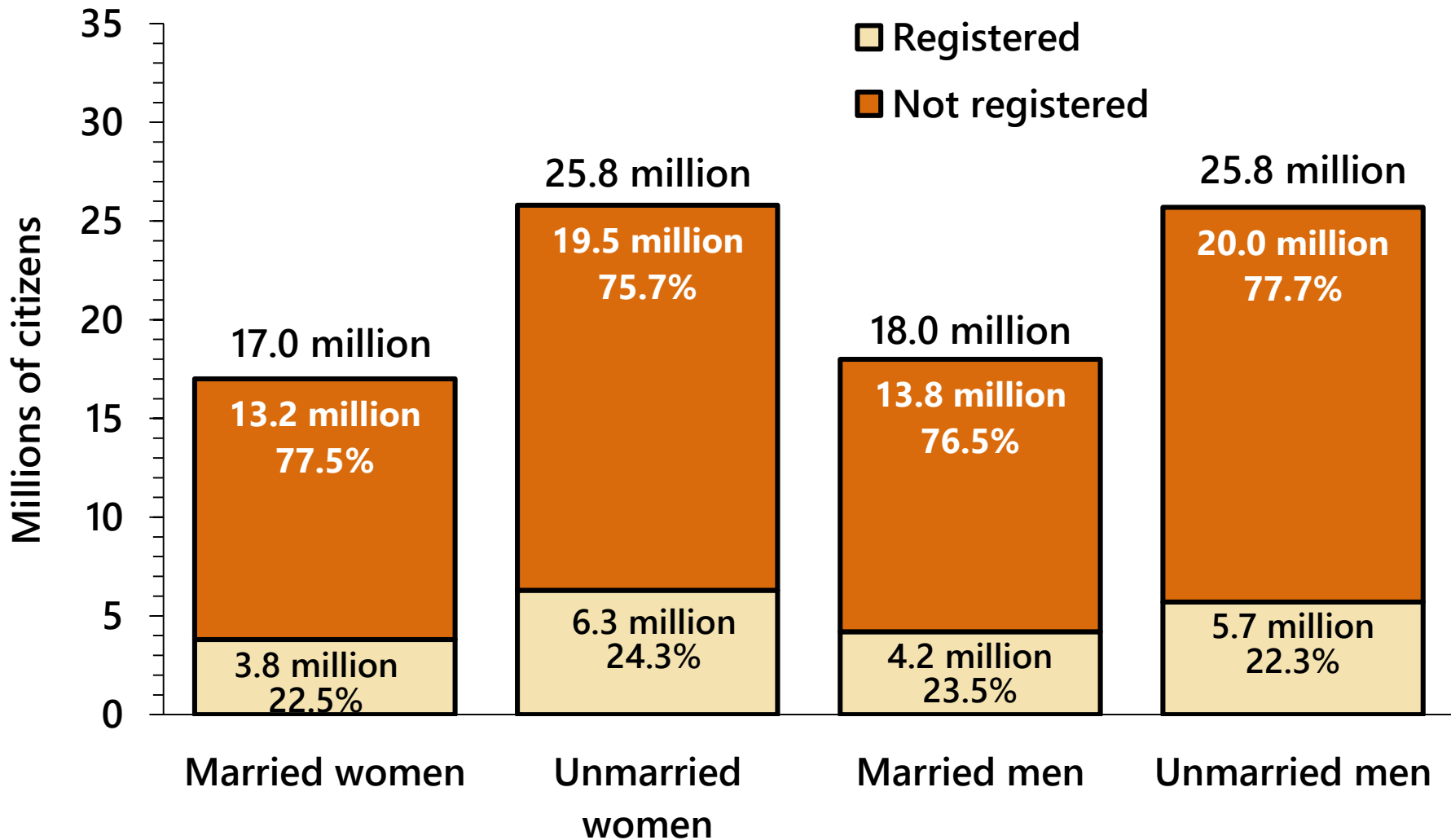

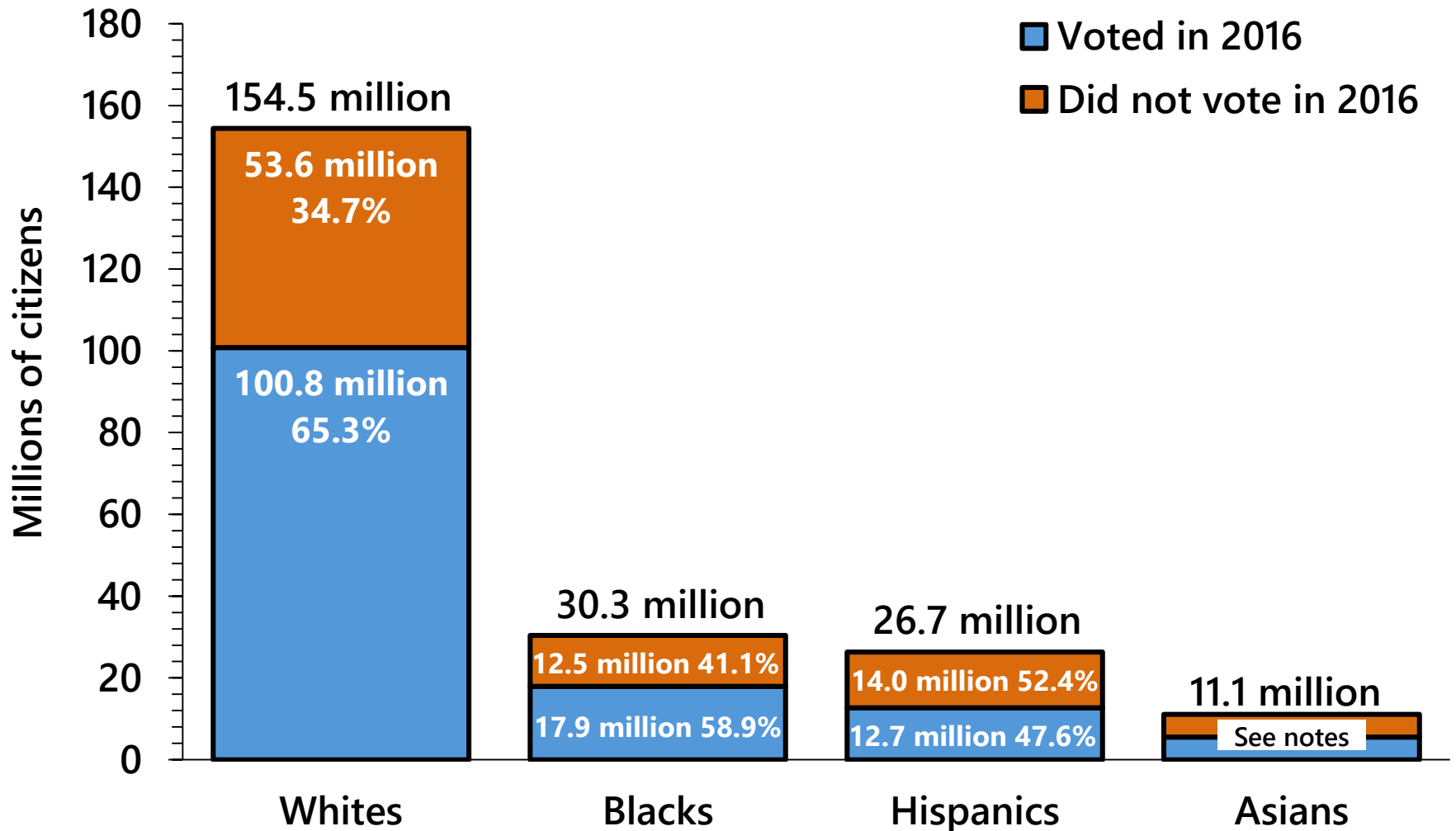

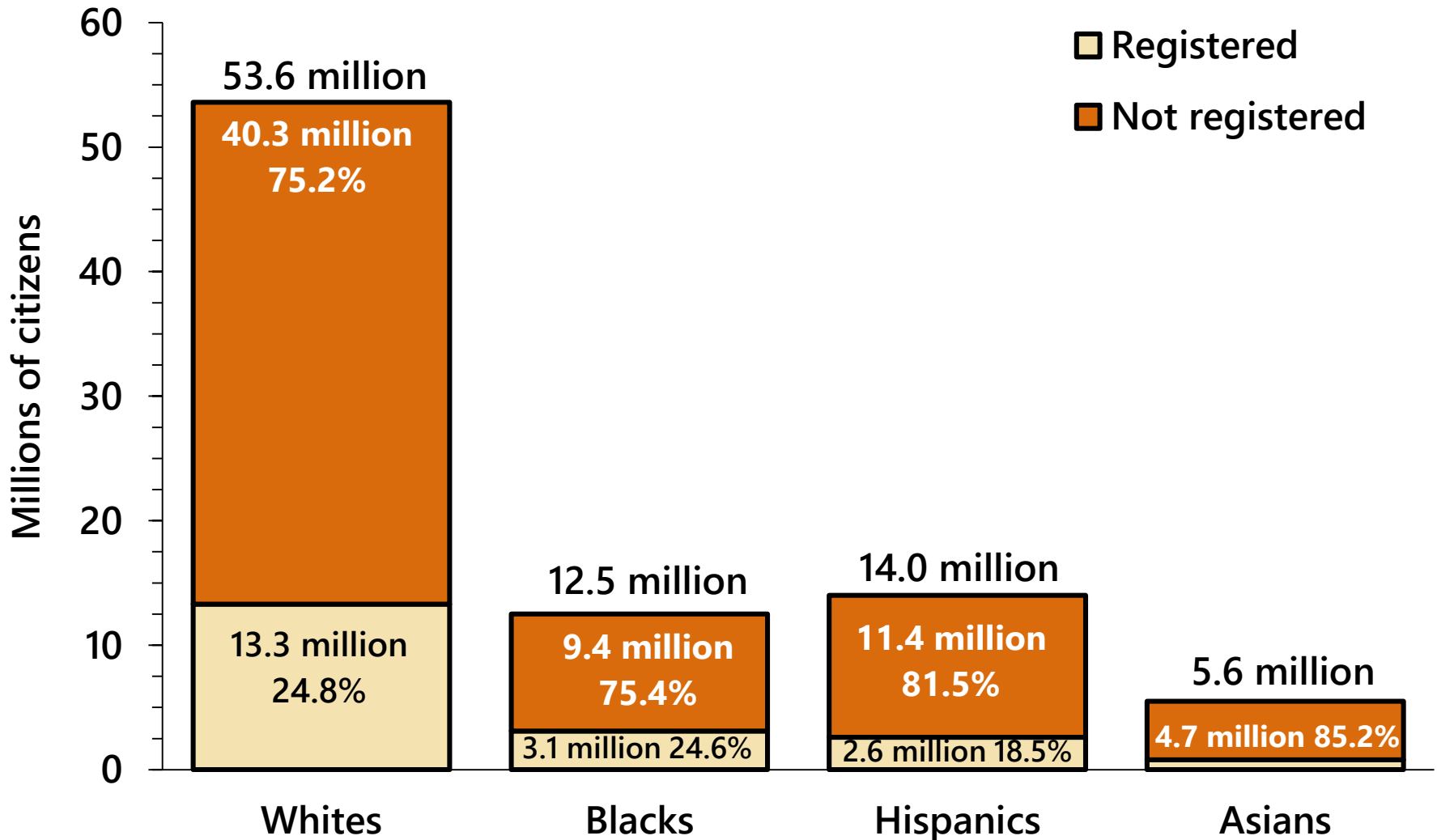

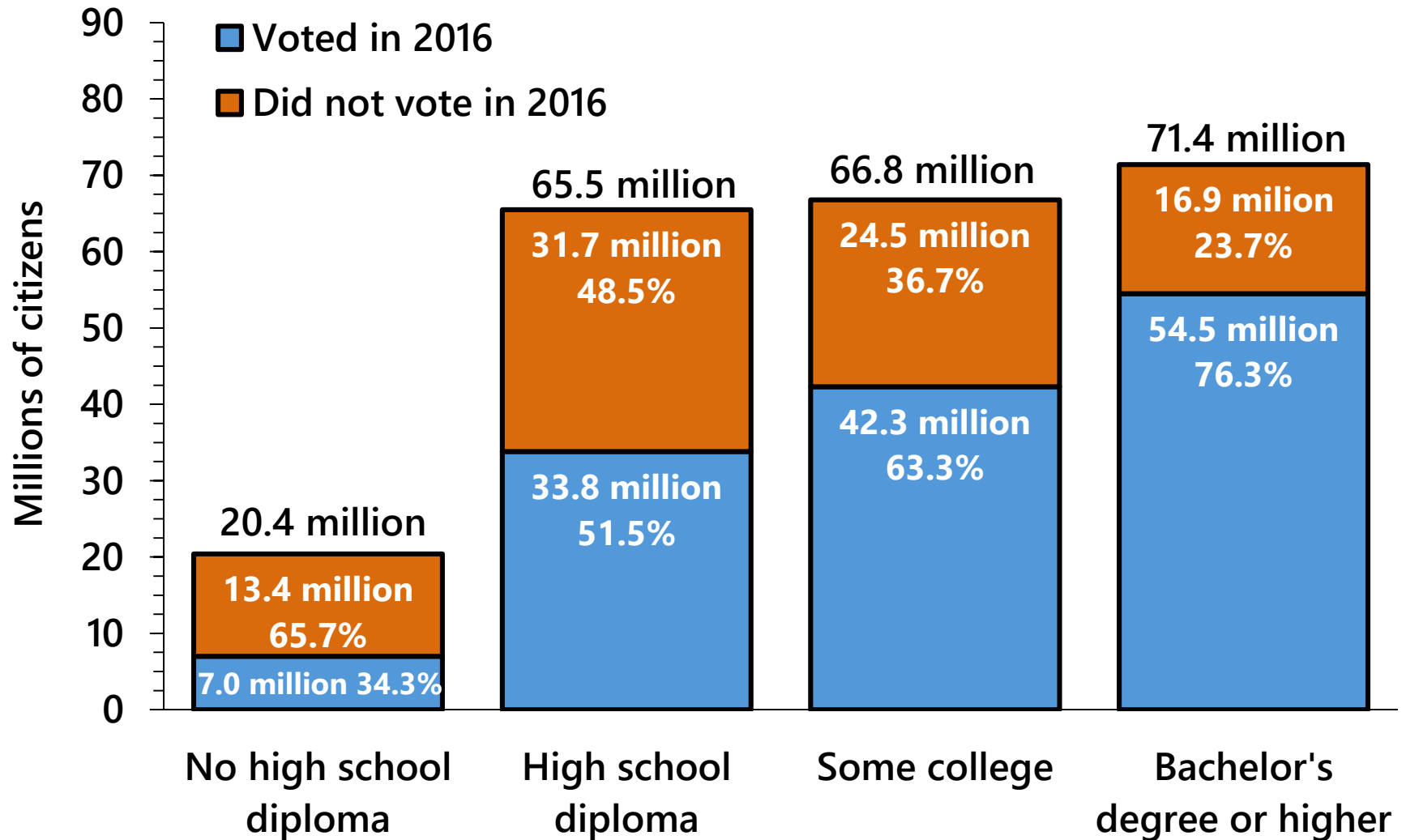

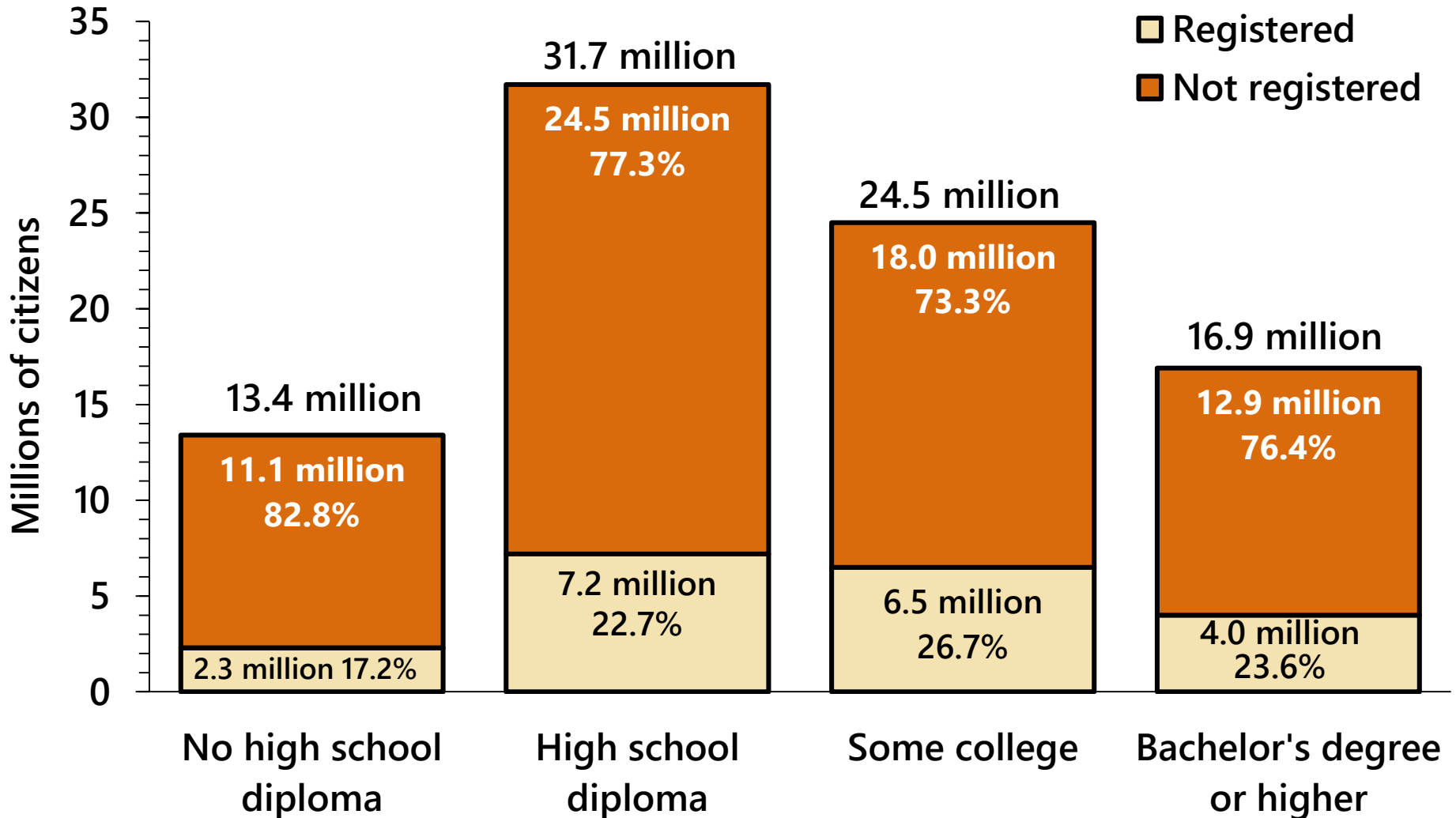

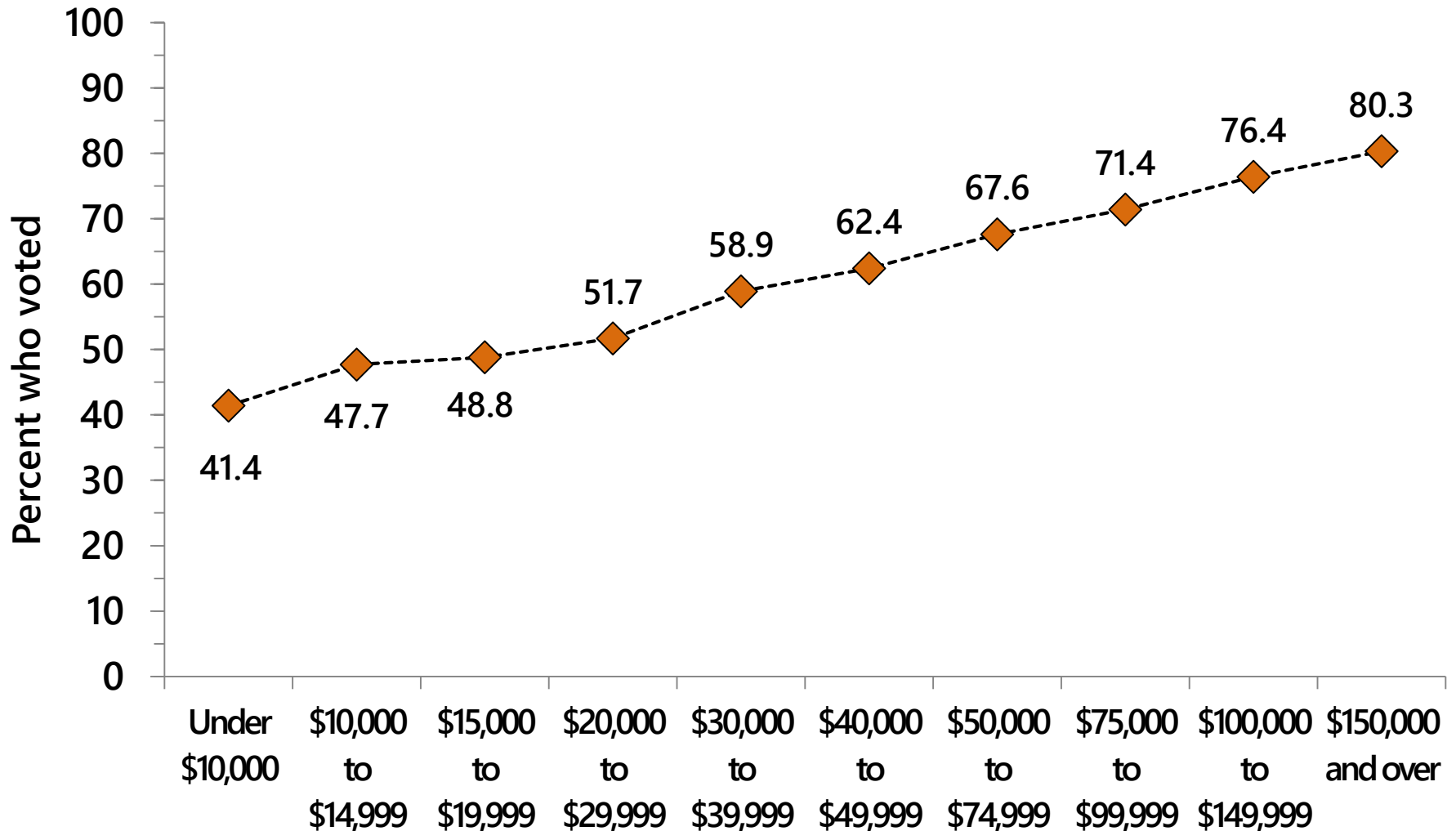

Citizens 18+ years old residing in families in 2016

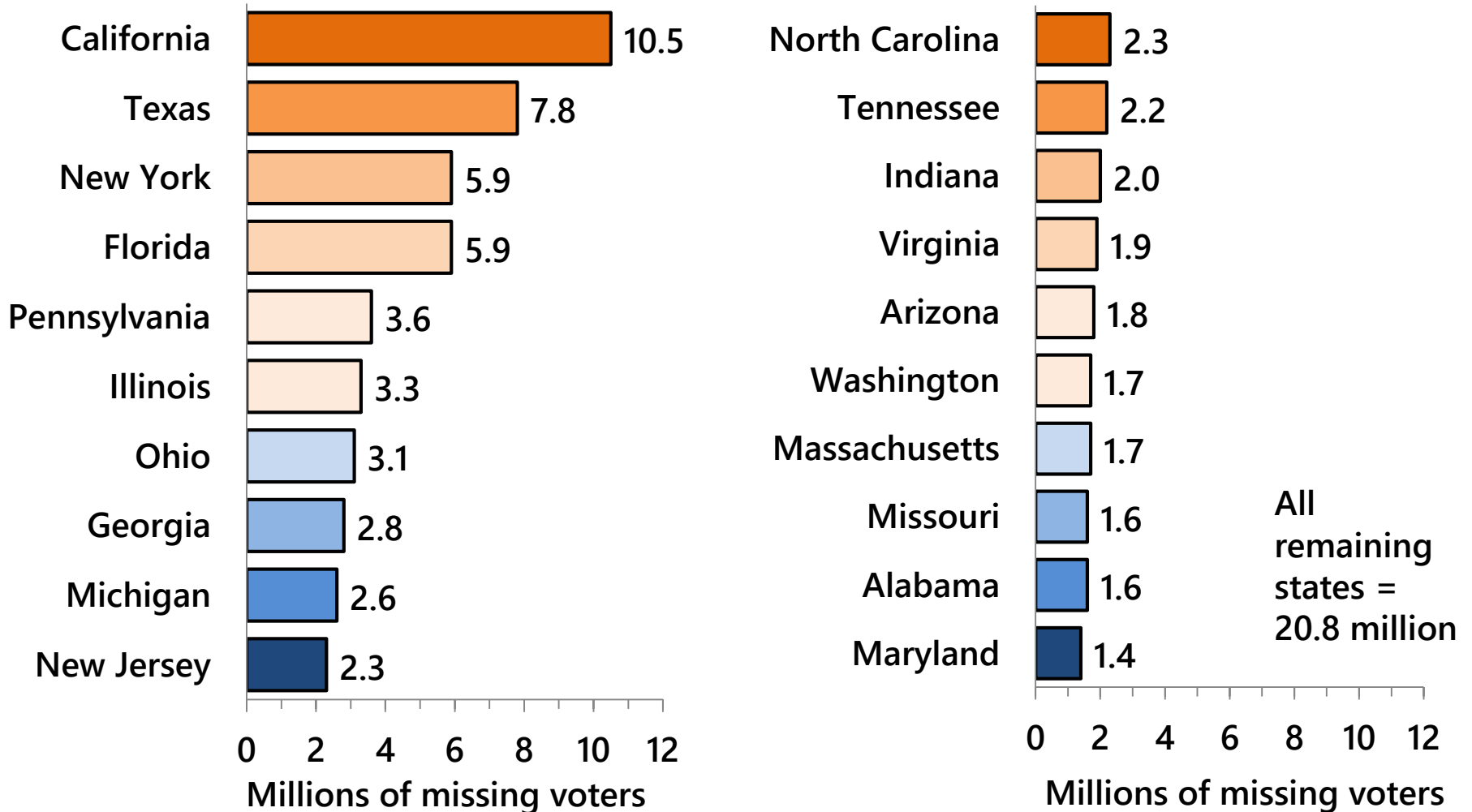
